Call to Order

The COCTYC meeting was called to order at 2:15 P.M. Action items were postponed due to lack of quorum.

Minutes of the 122nd Conference COCTYC Meeting

The Minutes of the COCTYC Meeting at the 122nd Conference were corrected as follows: "Bloomington" Community College was changed to "Normandale" and the spelling of "Elliott" was corrected.

Personnel Matters

David Klein reported on his meeting with Bob Kirkly and Wendell Massey about the duties and responsibilities of the position of Newsletter Editor.

Future Sites

Wendell Massey reported on future sites and confirmations. The Newsletter deadlines for receiving preliminary and final programs have been determined and will be sent to program chairs for 1994 Conferences.

Duane Sell and Elliott Greenberg will meet on Friday, June 4, with Ray Turner to discuss Roxbury, Massachusetts, as a possible conference site.

There was discussion regarding regional boundaries as listed in agenda books. The general consensus was that boundaries should be more fluid and regarded as guidelines to be used in site selection.

Treasurer's Report

Duane Sell reviewed the Statement of Income and Expenses. There are currently 129 college sponsors. There was some discussion as to how to increase college sponsors and individual memberships. He also summarized the archive holdings.

Membership Report

Dick Jones reported that there are presently 524 paid members of 2YC.

Industrial Sponsor's Report

Information provided by Pat Jones (not present at this meeting) indicated that there are currently 22 Industrial Sponsors.

Old Business

Newsletter Information: Duane Sell reported an additional \$300 received from ACE Glass for their ad.

It was determined that one and one-half pages of advertisements are necessary in order to fully fund the newsletter.

It was suggested that ads be solicited from existing industrial sponsors such as book publishing companies.

Elliott Greenberg offered to draw up a policy letter on payment (or prepayment) for ads for the newsletter. The committee will vote on this when the letter is ready.

There was discussion on the policy for types of news items to be run in the newsletter. The question: "Is it advertisement for the purpose of making money, or information about a service which might happen to cost money?" It was deemed, for example, acceptable to run information about a satellite T.V. program, but not acceptable to print an article about short courses during Chemistry Week.

Duties of COCTYC Officers was deferred due to lack of quorum.

Changes in Policies/Procedures was deferred due to lack of quorum.

Planning Guide: Elliott Greenberg's revision of the Conference Planning Guide (Part I) is to be used as was previously approved.

New Business

All new business was tabled until the committee reconvenes. It was decided that files for future conference sites are to be transferred to the Past Chair at the last fall meeting of each year.

Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 4:50 P.M.

Reconvenement

The meeting was reconvened at 5:30 P.M. on Friday, June 4, 1993. Those in attendance were members David Klein, Wendell Massey, Ed Heath, Elliott Greenberg, Duane Sell, and Margot Schumm and visitors Tamar Susskind, Terri Nally, and Robert Kirkly.

Old Business

Duties of COCTYC Officers: A working document was produced, which will be available at or before the meeting at the 124th Conference.

Policies/Procedures: It was voted to table the discussion on changes until a later date.

J.J. Lagowski's Editorial: It was agreed that Margot Schumm would compose a letter to be sent to J.J. Lagowski in response to his letter.

Action Item: It was voted to allow Robert Kirkly, Newsletter Editor, to select and purchase a computer publishing program with COCTYC funds. The maximum amount is to be less than \$700 and the program is to be registered to the COCTYC.

Site Selection: There was a brief discussion of Roxbury, Massachusetts, as a future conference site.

Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 6:25 P.M.
