OPENING:

The meeting was opened at 9:00 A.M. by the Chair, David Klein.

REPORTS:

123rd Conference

David Klein gave a report on the 123rd Conference at Warwick, Rhode Island.

Treasurer's Report

Duane Sell provided the treasurer's report.

College Sponsors

Duane Sell reported that at present there are 130 college sponsors. All persons in attendance were urged to have their institutions become college sponsors.

Membership

Dick Jones reported a membership of 526 before the current conference and expressed the hope that the number would exceed 700 by year's end.

Industrial Sponsors

Pat McCoy-Brown reported 20 industrial sponsors to date and encouraged participants to help solicit additional sponsors. The \$100 fee entitles the sponsor to exhibit at all four conferences for that year.

Future Sites

Wendell Massey provided an update on meeting sites. This information will appear in the agenda book for the 125th Conference.

DIVISION OF CHEMICAL EDUCATION NEWS:

There was a discussion of J.J. Lagowski's editorial in the Journal of Chemical Education which addressed four-year versus two-year transfer students. David Klein and Margot Schumm reported that a response should be forthcoming soon from the COCTYC. There will also be a symposium at the next Biennial dealing with this concern. A letter will appear in the Journal of Chemical Education.

NSF GRANTS:

SUMMARY REPORT OF THE 124th CONFERENCE:

Michaelleen Lee gave a summary report of the conference, adding that the new Conference Planning Guide was very helpful. There were approximately 92 in attendance. She was congratulated on a fine conference.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. by Chair David Klein.

MINUTES OF THE 123rd CONFERENCE:

The minutes of the COCTYC Meeting at the 123rd Conference were approved with spelling correction of Robert Kirkley's name.

PERSONNEL MATTERS:

Pat McCoy-Brown resigned as Industrial Sponsors Chair, effective January 1, 1994. Carol White was approved by a unanimous vote to be appointed the new Industrial Sponsors Chair for a three year period beginning January 1, 1994. An advertisement for a new Assistant Industrial Sponsors Chair is to appear in the first newsletter of 1994 with nominations due to the chair by the first spring meeting (March 11-12, 1994).

FUTURE SITES:

Wendell Massey gave an updated report on future conference sites. All confirmed updates and changes will appear in the next agenda book for the 125th Conference. Elliott Greenberg provided information on the letter from Ray Turner withdrawing Roxbury Community College as the conference site for the 134th Conference.

A discussion ensued on possible better site planning with a new regional map for future conferences.

ACTION ITEM: A motion was made that a representative for any future conference site be required to attend at least one scheduled conference within two years prior to their conference. In addition, a letter reminding the host institution of this will be sent with the \$250 "seed" money for the conference planning. Motion passed with one abstention.

TREASURER/COLLEGE SPONSORS:

Duane Sell reviewed the printed treasurer's report and reported 130 college sponsors at present. A discussion ensued on increasing this number.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT:

Dick Jones reported 526 paid members at present, plus 92 in attendance at the 124th Conference.

INDUSTRIAL SPONSORS:

Pat McCoy-Brown reported 20 Industrial Sponsors with hopes of 25 by the year's end.

OLD BUSINESS:

Newsletter Information

A discussion ensued on the policy affecting payment (or prepayment) of advertisements to be run in the newsletter. Elliott Greenberg made a motion that the COCTYC require all advertisers to prepay before advertisements are run in the newsletter. Following considerable discussion, the motion was defeated by a vote of four to three. There was also a discussion on the policy of what the Chair and Newsletter Editor are allowed to print in the newsletter without committee approval.

Lagowski's Editorial in Journal of Chemical Education

David Klein and Margot Schumm gave a report on their meeting with J.J. Lagowski and provided assurance that the response from the COCTYC would be printed in the Journal of Chemical Education. It was decided that members are to read the letter draft and submit to her, in writing, any additions or changes. The draft is to be finalized at the 125th meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Regional Advisory Board Members

Dick Jones is to submit a draft of a procedure for assignments for Regional Advisory Board Members at the next meeting.

Instrumentation Workshop

Dick Jones provided a report on an NSF proposal for an instrumentation workshop at the University of Dayton. It was agreed that he would use the 2YC, mailing list to make the details of this workshop available to 2YC, members.

137th Conference

Carol White was appointed as the official COCTYC liaison for the 137th Conference in conjunction with the 14th ACS Biennial Conference.

Budget Information

Duane Sell provided information and concerns on the 1994 budget. Some discussion ensued on how to increase income.
