CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 8:35 A.M. by the Chair, Wendell Massey.

MINUTES OF THE 125TH CONFERENCE:

The minutes were read and approved.

PERSONNEL MATTERS:

Ballots for 1995 Chair Elect were presented by David Klein and counted. John Kenkel of Southeast Community College-Lincoln was selected as 1995 Chair Elect. All persons on the ballot will be notified by Wendell Massey.

There were no ballots for the position of Treasurer, as no complete applications were received. Duane Sell has agreed to serve as Treasurer for one more year.

Mary Graff of Amarillo College was named the Assistant Industrial Sponsors Chair. Wendell Massey will notify her.

FUTURE SITES:

Wendell Massey, Robert Kirkley and Carol White expressed concern over having the conferences too close together. It is difficult to prepare the Newsletter and agenda books, if there is not a minimum of six weeks between conferences. Most industrial sponsors will not run ads in consecutive Newsletters published within one month of each other.

Bill Haley of San Antonio College in San Antonio, Texas, will host the 139th Conference in the late Fall of 1996. Ralph Burns will contact someone in the St. Louis area for the 144th Conference.

BUDGET REPORT:

The budget report prepared by Duane Sell was reviewed. It was moved and seconded that beginning January 1, 1995, dues/conference fees be increased from \$10.00 to \$15.00. The motion was passed.

COLLEGE SPONSORS:

MEMBERSHIP REPORT:

INDUSTRIAL SPONSORS:

NEWSLETTER INFORMATION:

Robert Kirkley reported on the printing of the 94-I Newsletter. The approximate cost was \$900.00. He strongly recommended that the organization seek an outside printer, independent of any two-year college, when his term expires. The matter was tabled until the 127th Conference.

OLD BUSINESS:

 C_3 Representative: David Klein will represent 2YC₃ at the C₃ meeting this year in Canada. It was recommended that 2YC₃ send someone each year to the annual C₃ meeting. David Klein will send a copy of the C₃ report of the 1993 joint meeting of C₃/2YC₃ in Rhode Island to the president of the host school in Rhode Island.

13th Biennial Margot Schumm reported on plans for the 13th Biennial Conference. 2YC₃ will have a booth with visors and balloons available, take part in a poster session and participate in a symposium discussing the four-year student versus two-year transfer student in obtaining the baccalaureate degree. David Klein suggested a COCTYC member be appointed to be involved with each biennial. Carol White is the appointed member for this year.

<u>James Sells Letter</u>: Ann Cartwright will obtain written permission to print in the Newsletter James Sells' review of the Ford Foundation Study.

<u>DivCHED-COCTYC</u>: Margot Schumm emphasized the importance of having a member of COCTYC as a voting member of DivCHED. She recommended that the committee petition to become a voting member and asked for recommendations of how to approach DivCHED with this request. It was suggested to include in the petition the number of chemistry students in two-year colleges, the outreach programs to women and minority students, etc. It was suggested that the immediate past-chair serve as the voting member, when this position is created.

<u>COCTYC Flow Chart</u>: A flow chart prepared by Margot Schumm was distributed, but the discussion of the chart was tabled until the 127th Conference.

Regional Advisory Board Member: Discussion of the responsibilities and appointment of members was tabled until the 127th Conference.

NEW BUSINESS:

Safety Exam: David Klein reported that Carl Gottschall of Littleton, Colorado, wants to have prepared an ACS Health and Safety Exam. The committee decided not to endorse the project at this time.

Workshop for a Future Conference: Wendell Massey reported that Irwin Talesnick has requested to give a presentation at a future conference at the cost of \$80.00 per person in

attendance. The committee requested that Wendell talk with Talesnick to see if the cost might be reduced.

NSF Workshops: Dick Jones reported on the workshops planned for the summer of 1994. As a part of faculty enhancement, there are two instrument workshops planned at three sites for one week each. It was moved and seconded that a letter from Wendell Massey in behalf of COCTYC supporting the workshops and requesting membership in the coalition be written. The motion passed
