146TH Two-Year College Chemistry Conference General Membership Meeting

Bismarck State College Bismarck, North Dakota September 18, 1998

The meeting was called to order by Carol White at 11:35 A.M.. In the absence of Tom Gruber, Michaeleen Lee assumed the responsibility of Recording Secretary.

I. Introductions

The following were present and introduced themselves:
COCTYC Members: Carol White, Chair; Dick Jones, Immediate Past
Chair/Membership Chair; John Kenkel, Past Chair; Michaeleen Lee, Industrial Sponsors
Chair. Other attendees introduced themselves and stated their school affiliation.

II. Minutes from the 144th Conference, Tarrant County Junior College

The minutes of the 144th Conference are on page 2 of the 146th Agenda Book. The minutes were approved as written.

Carol White explained that 2YC₃ stands for The Two-Year College Chemistry Consortium and is the organization run by the executive committee of the Committee on Chemistry in the Two-Year College, COCTYC, a committee of the Division of Chemical Education of the American Chemical Society. The mission of 2YC₃ is to conduct four conferences annually. This is the 146th 2YC₃ Conference. Carol pointed out that information about COCTYC members can be found on the front cover of the Newsletter and on the front page of the Agenda Book. Chair Emeriti are listed on page 49.

III. Reports

A. Tarrant County Junior College Conference, March 27-28, 1998

Carol White presented the report on the Tarrant County Junior College meeting for Tom Gruber. The meeting was held on March 27-28, 1998. She stated that the theme of the conference was "Chemistry in the New Millennium: The Future in the Classroom, Research, and Technology." The conference was well attended. The conference program contained many presentations that emphasized current research in superconducting polymers, the interaction of two-year colleges with high schools, distance learning, the viewpoint of industry on the role of the two-year college, and the use of the web in chemical education. The banquet was held at the Fort Worth Museum of Science and History.

B. Treasurer's Report

John Kenkel presented the budget report for Jeff Cramer. The report is printed on pages 13-14 of the 146th Agenda Book. John stated that the organization is doing well financially. However, it should be noted that extensive travel expenses are forth coming.

C. College Sponsor's Report

John also gave the College Sponsors report. A list of College Sponsors can be found on page 15 of the Agenda Book. The report shows 113 sponsors. He encouraged everyone whose college was not already a sponsor to become one. The College Sponsor form is on page 35 of the Agenda Book. Members present were asked to check the information listed for their college and let a member of COCTYC know of any needed corrections.

D. Membership

Dick Jones pointed out the membership report on page 36 of the Agenda Book. As of September 27, there are 865 total members with 455 renewals. He also noted that 85 members have taken the advantage of the opportunity to join both the Division of Chemical Education and 2YC₃. He mentioned that this offer is for members of 2YC₃ that are not members of the Division of Chemical Education. A form on page 4 of the current newsletter can be used to take advantage of this offer.

E. Industrial Sponsors

Michaeleen Lee reported that there are 18 Industrial Sponsors as shown on page 39 of the Agenda Book. She encouraged everyone to help recruit new Sponsors among companies and businesses with whom they do business. It is important to approach marketing managers especially with regard to publishing companies. She suggested that you start with your local rep and work up the chain of command to the marketing manager. She noted that Simon & Schuster is not a separate sponsor as it is the paying company for Prentice Hall.

F. Future Meeting Sites

John Kenkel reported on future sites. The conference calendar for the next several years can be found on page 40 with more detailed information about each conference on the pages that follow. The 159th Conference is the last one that has been officially scheduled. The 17th Biennial will be held at Western Washington University. John reminded everyone that the next conference will be the 147th Conference to be held at Florida Community College in Jacksonville, Florida on November 20-21, 1998.

G. Newsletter/Web Page

Carol White gave the Newsletter/Web Page report. She encouraged everyone to visit the 2YC₃ web site and to take advantage of the links and services it offers. The address is listed in the Newsletter. She invited those present to send to Jay Bardole materials that they would like to see in the newsletter.

H. DivCHED

Carol also reported on DivCHED activities. Ann Cartwright is 2YC₃'s liaison to DivCHED. Carol then gave details on how to become a member of DivCHED. She urged all 2YC₃ members that are not members of DivCHED to become either full or affiliate members of the Division. She reminded everyone that affiliate members do have voting privileges.

IV. Announcements and New Business

A. 15th Biennial and 16th Biennials

Dick Jones gave a report on the 15th Biennial which was held at the University of Waterloo, Waterloo, Canada. The meeting dates were August 9-13, 1998. He passed out brochures containing information on the 16th Biennial which will be held in Ann Arbor, Michigan in the summer of 2000. The University of Michigan is the host institution. The brochure contains the deadlines for submitting symposia ideas. Dick pointed out that members need not limited themselves to 2YC₃ issues when considering the organization of a symposium. Dick is the Two-Year Program Chair for the this Biennial.

B. Summer Instrumentation Workshops

Dick reported on the NSF funded Summer Instrumentation Workshop that has been conducted at Sinclair Community College as well as other affiliated colleges for the past few years. As NSF has shifted its funding emphasis to teacher education, 1999 will be the last summer that these workshops will be conducted.

C. Other

Dennis Mathiason addressed the group and pointed out the benefits of membership in the American Chemical Society. He urged those present that are not members to join.
