

153rd Two Year College Chemistry Consortium General Membership Minutes Hudson Valley Community College Albany, New York October 6-7, 2000

Rick Bolesta called the meeting to order, at Hudson Valley Community College, at 10:30 am, Saturday, October 6, 2000.

I. Introductions:

Those present at the meeting introduced themselves. COCTYC members present were Rick Bolesta, Frank Koch, Tom Gruber, Rick Jones, Dolores, and Jeff Cramer.

II. Minutes

A. Rick Bolesta noted that the minutes for the 152nd 2YC₃ Conference held at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan, held July 30 – August 3, 2000, are found on page 2 of the agenda book.

III. Reports:

- A. Frank Koch reported on the 152nd 2YC₃ Conference held at the University of Michigan in conjunction with the 16th Biennial Conference on Chemical Education, July 30 – August 3, 2000. Symposia topics included: Innovations in Technician Education, Distance Learning Methods, Computer Technology in Chemical Instruction, Chemistry and the Automobile, Teaching Nontraditional students, Broadening the General Chemistry Laboratory, Assessment of Student Outcomes, Innovations and Reform at Community Colleges, and many more. Monday evening the 2YC₃ cosponsored, with the Journal of Chemical Education, an ice cream social. The general meeting of the 2YC₃ was held at 12:30 pm Tuesday, August 1. A survey was conducted regarding ways to make the 2YC₃ more helpful to its members. Some items discussed included: public relations to increase awareness of others about the existence and purpose of the organization, reaching out to our younger faculty to determine their needs, making our website more helpful, and possibly linking some 2YC₃ meetings with ACS regional or even national meetings.
- B. Treasurer's Report: Jeff Cramer provided a statement of income and expenses for the period of January 1 through September 22, 2000.

 A correction was noted: the subtotal under Operating Income should have been \$12,203.94 replacing \$10, 203.94.

 Jeff noted that the number of newspaper ads have increased over the past year.

- C. College Sponsors: Jeff Cramer noted there are 104 current college sponsors. The list is attached.
- D. Membership: Dolores Aquino noted the membership report is on page 8 of the agenda book. Currently there are 335 members for 2000, and 27 joint memberships with DivChed.
