What you need to bring to the first day of class:

<u>Tro Text</u> You do not have to have your text the very first day of class. The lines for the bookstore can be long and I'd rather have you in class rather than waiting in line. I also have copies of Chapter 2 & Chapter 3 for you to borrow until you can get your text.

<u>Calculator</u>: A scientific calculator such as a TI 30 (available at Walmart for less than \$10) In this class, graphing/ programmable calculators are not allowed on exams. There are scientific calculators available for check-out from the library for exam days and other class days.

<u>Mastering Chemistry access code</u>: This access code is bundled with the text (if you purchased the text new). This access code that will allow you to log on to the Mastering Chemistry site to download and submit online homework. Mastering Chemistry is not part of D2L but you can access it from D2L.

Positive attitude: Don't leave home without it.

Some students have asked if they can use the 3rd edition of Tro. That's fine but you will be responsible for getting together with a student that has the 4th edition and making sure you know which tables to learn, homework problems to do, etc... Not every problem and table correlates to the newer edition.

You will still need your own Mastering Chemistry Access Code that only you will use. You may not use an access code that another student has used....even a family member, as this violates copyright laws.
