WELCOME TO OUR COMPUTER SCIENCE PROGRAMS!

Anoka-Ramsey Community College's AS in Computer Science and Computer Programming Certificate target a broad range of students interested in careers in Information Technology. The AS program supports two tracks for students based on readiness, transfer and/or employment plans. The degree articulates to the Computer Science program at Metropolitan State University and the Bachelor of Applied Science degree at Minnesota State University, Mankato. The Certificate in Computer Programming is designed for holders of an AA, AS and/or baccalaureate degree who have an interest in a career change or job enhancement. The program shares curriculum with related courses from Business and Computer Networking to provide graduates with a diverse skill set.

Students expecting to continue their studies towards a Baccalaureate (BA or BS) degree in computer science should review transfer guides with their transferring institution prior to making elective selections.

The CSCI Program application assists in assessing your experience with computer programming along with your plan for completing a curriculum within an appropriate timeline. The Dean of Computer Science will review your application and notify you of program acceptance.

PROGRAM ADMISSION

To be accepted in the program the following items must be completed:

- Completion of Application for Admission to ARCC (new students only)
- Completion of CSCI Program Application
- Assessment testing
- Phone or personal interview with the Dean of Computer Science (you will be contacted to schedule the interview)

The dean will review applications for the CSCI program on an ongoing basis. Interested students are encouraged to apply early. The Dean will send a letter of approval/denial based on verified criteria.

NOTE: Admission is not required for CSCI 1101 or CSCI 1115.
