

Anoka-Ramsey Music Department Juries

1. Sign up for a jury time. Confirm date, time and place of jury with accompanist.
2. Rehearse with accompanist
3. Complete the jury forms provided by your instructor before the day of your jury.
4. Appearance is important. Dress appropriately.
 - Recommended attire for juries /performance hours**
 - Men:**
Dress slacks and shirts (ties optional), sports coats or dress sweaters, suits
 - Women:**
Business suits or pants suits, conservative dresses or skirt and blouse combinations
 - All:**
Unacceptable attire includes; Jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, sandals, tight or short skirts, T-shirts/tank tops and sweatshirts
5. Have all equipment ready to go when it is your turn to perform.
6. Make sure your accompanist is aware of your performance time and brings the music.
7. Be available for your jury at least ½ hour before your scheduled time.
8. Introduce yourself and the music you will be performing.
9. Acknowledge your accompanist and the audience (bow).
10. Set-up your equipment as needed.
 - a. Piano top set to correct height, amp plugged in, music stand available, etc.
11. Move equipment out of the way when you are finished or take the equipment with you when you are done.
12. Students that miss their performance time will have to wait until all others have performed.
13. Take time to tune your instrument to the piano.
