 - ✓ 3100 (01) Concepts in Nursing and Health Care Friday 9 - 1pm (4 credits) CC rm E241
 - ✓ 3110 (01) Altered Physiological Processes Friday 2 - 5pm (3 credits) CC rm E241
 - ✓ 3120 (91) Transcultural Nursing Online (2 credits) CC rm E241
- Students must complete AA degree: May be completed prior to or during program. For ARCC students, most can do this by completing the following courses (but students should meet with an advisor to verify their individual situation):
 - ✓ The best advice is for students to take SPCH 2220, as it fits into more goals areas
 - ✓ Other goal areas needed:
 - 4B, college level math – MATH 1110 recommended
 - Goal area 5A & 10 or 5C & 10 GEOG 1103, or GEOG 1108 or POLS 2202
 - Goal area 6B & 9 PHIL 1110
- Financial Aid: Students may receive financial aid from only 1 college at a time; Students may want to work on AA courses through ARCC during summer sessions
- Texts: Will be available at Cambridge Campus Bookstore
- Application: Students must apply to both BSU and the Nursing program. Students are admitted to the Nursing program on an ongoing basis.
 - ✓ Registered nurses may enroll in initial junior level (3100, 3110, 3120, 3130, 3200) courses prior to being formally admitted to major if enrollment space is available (preference given to admitted students)
 - Enrollment in these courses does not insure admission to nursing major
 - Admission to the major is required prior to enrolling in all other courses except 3920 courses and 3457
 - ✓ Applicants Must:
 - Be a graduate of a state approved associate degree or diploma (RN) nursing program
 - Be licensed to practice as a registered nurse in Minnesota or be a graduate with license pending
 - (Note: *Applicants in process of completing their final semester* in their nursing program, or awaiting licensure results, may be admitted with *provisional status*, assuming final transcript and licensure meet program requirements)
 - Be formally admitted to Bemidji State University
 - Submit a completed Department of Nursing Application Form to the Department of Nursing
 - Submit your current Minnesota RN license number to the Department of Nursing
 - Have access to Internet and e-mail
