This student is applying for acceptance into the Upward Bound program sponsored by Anoka-Ramsey Community College. In addition to completing an in-depth application, we request that the student seek two nominations: one from their teacher and one from a counselor so that we can accept the most qualified and motivated students.

Upward Bound is designed as a year-round, pre-college support program for high school **students who demonstrate the interest and ability to go on to post-secondary education**. The goal of the program is to develop the skills necessary to succeed in college. We prepare students through one-on-one weekly tutoring and other academic skill-building sessions, social and cultural activities, college and career exploration, and academic advising. Upward Bound develops the learning potential of high school **students from limited income families and/or families whose parents have not completed a four-year college degree**. The Upward Bound program is a TRIO program that is funded by the U.S. Department of Education.

Anoka-Ramsey Community College's Upward Bound serves 50 students enrolled at Cambridge-Isanti, North Branch, and Princeton High Schools.
