

CIHS REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- Students will register online during the week of January 30th-February 6th before or after school, during a study hall, or from home.
- It is important for all students grade 9-11 to attend all advisory sessions. Seniors will be required to leave or report to the gymnasium during the first four advisory sessions.

The following information provides a general guideline for registration. For specific questions please contact your registration advisor or your counselor.

- A term course is worth 1 credit; a semester course is worth 2 credits. There are a few exceptions to these statements.
- Students must register for both the “A” and “B” sections of most courses. The second or subsequent courses in a series (II, III, IV) are not required to be taken in the same semester or year.
- Students wanting to repeat a course must meet with their counselor for prior approval.
- Students may only register for **one** full block study hall each year.
- Register carefully as you must be committed to the choices you have made. After you have registered, schedule changes will not be made.
- **It is the student’s responsibility to assure that all graduation requirements are met.** Ask questions if you are not sure about your requirements.

Registration Process and Advisory

Registration for students in grades 9-11 will take place in advisory groups. Each student will be assigned to an advisory group and will meet with the same advisor and group throughout the registration process.

Listed below is a summary of the registration process.

- Students meet for four sessions with their advisory groups to review graduation requirements, examine course descriptions and select courses they plan to take the following year. Grade level pre-registration forms are given to students and filled out during advisory.
- Completed registration forms are sent home for parent review and signature.
- Signed registration forms are returned to the registration advisor.
- Students will register online for next year's courses. Students are encouraged to register for next year's courses online from home. Students also have the option of registering online from a school computer before school, after school, or during a study hall.
